Jaguar X150 XK/XKR headliners

- Canvas Morzine Cloth - early cars, it is NOT the suede fabric, it's a velour/felt fabric Canvas is the name of the colour.

- Canvas Alston Suede - this is in 2008-onward cars, If you have a light-coloured suede, this is what you have

- Warm Charcoal Alston Suede - this was only in the limited edition 2009MY XKR-S Nobody outside the UK/EU has this (200 cars only)

- Jet Alston Suede - this is the dark-coloured suede in 2010MY-onward cars. If you have dark suede, this is it.

- Canvas Poltrona Frau - this is actual leather, not suede

- Jet Poltrona Frau - this is actual leather, not suede

So if your headliner is not suede, not leather, it's the Canvas Morzine fabric. If you have a light colour suede headliner, it's Canvas If you have the dark colour suede headliner, it's Jet


Doesn't matter if your seats are Ivory, Caramel, Warm Charcoal, the headliner is one of two colours.
